**2 SCHEDULE:** The **Final** event competition schedule is posted on our website. Rooms still need to be assigned, but the event times have not. Rooms and locations will be updated as we select rooms to accommodate the competitors.

**3 TEAM NUMBER and EVENT RESERVATION:** After you register a team, you will receive a team number and login. This login will allow you to reserve times for each event. Under the FAQ tab the **Event Time Slot Reservation Site**. If you have already registered, watch your email. Last minute Walk-Ins are welcome assuming we have space. Teams with reservations have priority.

**4. REGISTRATION: BSU PHOTO RELEASE FORM & TEAM ROSTER)** Make sure each of your students and their parent/guardian complete and sign the BSU **Photo/Video Release Form**. Also, complete your **Team Roster Form** for each team. You will hand those forms in when you sign-in Saturday morning between 8:00 and 9:00 AM at the top of the stairs in the BSU Student Union Building (SUB) or in the ISU Physics Building. The BSU SUB's doors open at 8:00 AM. Event competition begins at 9:00 AM.
