The important thing is to first download a copy of the rules for 2026. Note that the B division rules are for grades 6 -9 and the C division rules are for grades 9 – 12. Students in 9<sup>th</sup> grade have a choice of division in which they wish to compete. The rules can be found at:

While a school can have multiple teams, each team is limited to fifteen students and Division B teams are limited to five ninth graders while Division C teams are limited to seven twelfth graders. See:
